Adoptive Parent & Relative Caregiver Respite & Family Support Events	Fun events for families with adopted children or families caring for relative children. Call for dates and times
Food Distribution	Every Tuesday and Friday 1:00pm
Differential Response (DR) Program Services	Case Management and In-Home Parent Education for Social Services Agency Families. Referrals are made directly by the assigned social worker only.
Domestic Violence Counseling	Therapy for victims that focuses on domestic violence issues including but not limited to problem solving skills, emotional support, taking control over life situation and enhanced self-esteem. Childcare provided.
Domestic Violence Legal Assistance	Legal Assistance for domestic violence victims which include restraining orders, custody issues, dissolutions/divorce and legal counseling. Appointment required.
Emergency Assistance	Assistance with basic need items.
Family Advocacy	Case management to assist and link families to agencies in the community per their needs. Childcare provided.
Folkloric Dance Group	Traditional Mexican dance class for children ages 5-18, \$25 monthly fee and one time registration fee of \$25
Individual, Family and Group Counseling	Therapy topics include but are not limited to independent living skills, self-control, cycles of abuse and victimization, and modifying dysfunctional behaviors. Services available for adults & children. Please call for an appointment. Childcare provided.
Information and Referral	Assistance in locating resources such as health care, child care, legal aid, housing, educational classes, food and emergency needs.

Parenting Education Classes	Series of classes for parents on topics such as: logical consequences, modeling appropriate behavior, self control during stressful situations and communication skills. Childcare provided. Please call for dates and times.
