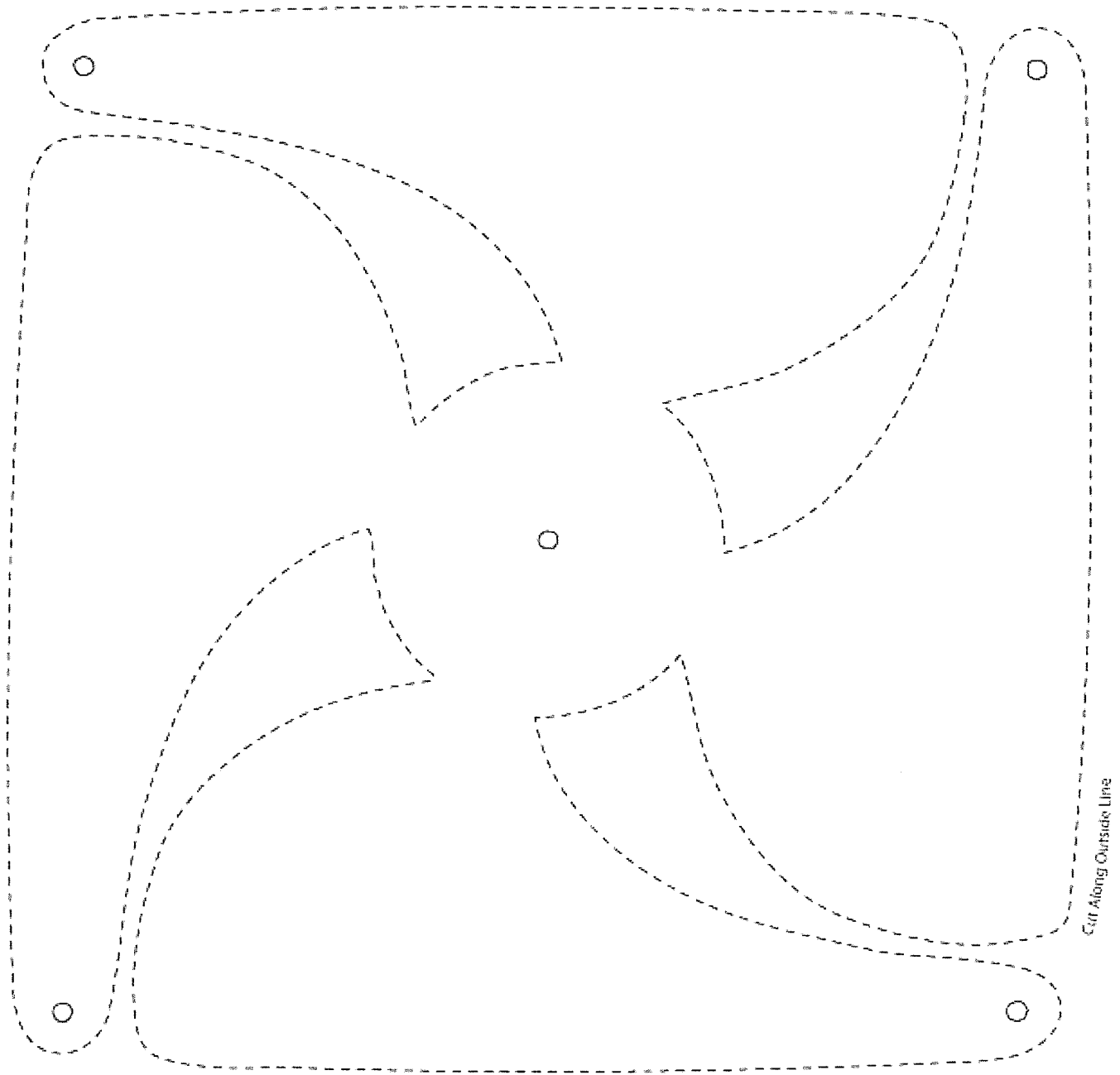


# Printable Pinwheels

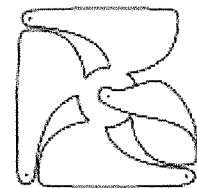


## Creativity Tips For a double-sided effect

Generously glue a piece of wrapping paper to the back of the pinwheel before you cut it out.  
Or print this onto the white side of pre-printed scrapbooking paper.

## Instructions:

Cut out pinwheel and fold corners marked with circles into the center.  
Secure with glue onto a wooden dowel or pin onto a pencil eraser.  
Blow it to spin and enjoy!

# Anatomy of the **PINWHEEL**

**Blades-** each blade provides strength and momentum for the other. The blades represent each part of **The Whole Child's** health... physical/ mental, social, spiritual, economic, and safety.

**Center Pin-** This piece holds the whole pinwheel together, without the structure the pin provides it would not truly be a pinwheel. The pin is like a **healthy family** who will provide the structure and security for the child to grow into a healthy adult.

**Dowel -** supports the pinwheel. Without this piece, the pinwheel would not stand or function. The dowel represents the **community**. With community support and collaboration, children can stand tall and reach their full potential.
