<u>California Safely Surrendered Baby Law</u> allows parents or lawful custodians to bring their newborn baby, up to three days old (72 hours), to employees or staff at a hospital emergency room, all fire stations displaying safe surrender signs (see above) or Orangewood Children's Home in Orange County.

## Facts about California Safely Surrendered Baby Law:

- ♦ Protects the child and the parent or lawful custodian
- ♦ Parents have three days (72 hours) from birth to surrender their child
- ♦ Allows 14 days for parents to change their mind after surrender
- Parents or lawful custodians are protected from prosecution for abandonment
